

## Digital Imaging with Krita software

### Lesson 2

(Layers)

#### Open a file

>File >Open

Browse to find a .kra file you already made

Or quickly make a new file and some simple new drawing

#### Simplify your Workspace

Use the same workspace as before

>Window >Workspace

>Big Paint


We will delete some of the menus on the far right  
(because we won't be using them)

Far right menu,

At bottom is “*Brush Presets*”

Click the X in its right corner to close it


Do the same for “*Tool Options*” to close it



#### Make a new layer

Under the “Color Selector” menu now is “Layers”

At bottom of “Layers”, click the + icon



## Digital Imaging with *Krita* software

### Lesson 2 (Layers)

This makes a new, empty “Paint Layer”  
on top of your first layer

In this new layer,...

Draw something simple  
(Use the *Freehand Brush* tool)

We will change some settings for this layer

#### Visibility of layer

In the Layers menu (far right menu)

Click the eyeball icon to left of “*Paint Layer*”  
This layer is now hidden  
Click the eyeball icon again to make the layer visible

#### Opacity of layer

In the same *Layers* menu (far right menu)...

Drag the “*Opacity*” bar to change opacity  
Everything on that layer is now partially transparent

#### **Make a third layer**

In *Layers* menu, hit **+** icon at bottom to make another layer  
It will be called *Paint Layer <number>*

#### Name the layer

Double-click on name of the new *Paint Layer* layer  
Change name of layer to “*Test*”

Draw something on *Test* layer

#### Change order of layers

Click to drag *Test* layer below *Paint Layer*

The *Test* drawing is now underneath it

#### **Save your file**

>File >Save As  
Save another .kra file  
But use a different filename
