

Digital Imaging with *Krita* software

Tutorial 5 (Transforms)

Create or Open a canvas

>File >Open
Browse to find one of your .kra files
or...

>File >New
Quickly draw something

Make sure your file has at least two layers

Transform a Layer

In the *Layers* docket
click on one of the layers to make it active


Left column of icons...

Select the *Transform* icon (square with dots at corners)



Move your cursor into the center of drawing area

Click and drag
The entire layer moves



Click on one of the squares at a corner of the rectangle
Drag it to make the entire layer smaller or larger
or to squash or stretch it

Move your cursor near (but not on) one of the corners
The icon change to a rotation icon
Drag left or right to rotate the layer




To exit & keep your transformation,
Click the *Select Shape* arrow icon (top left of left column)

(To exit but not keep, hit Esc key on your keyboard)

Transform a Selection Area

Choose one of the *Selection* area icons
(dotted-line icons, bottom of left column)
Make a selection area on one of your layers



Choose the *Transform* icon again
Transform will now affect only the selected area of the layer
Move, Scale, or Rotate the selected area
