


“Classical” story structure

Aristotle (~350 B.C.) (*Poetics*)



introduce:

- * main characters
- * setting (milieu)
- * conflict(s)

- * a sequence of conflict situations
- * the tension mounts with each
- * conflict become more difficult/intense

- * conflict resolved
- * tensions released
- * story wraps up
