

Practicum Exhibition

Fall 2016

All students enrolled in sections of DDA-610, Digital Arts Practicum will participate in a Practicum Exhibition at the end of the Fall semester. Each student will have one artwork exhibited. The decision which artwork to exhibit will be made by the student and his/her Practicum instructor.

Your participation in the Practicum Exhibition contributes to your grade for the Practicum course. "Participation" here means not only the artwork you exhibit, but your contributions to the exhibition preparations, installation, and deinstallation.

All students are responsible for helping with the arrangements for the exhibition. Lists of which students are doing what tasks can be found below

Written proposal

Due **11/10/16**. Each student must submit a proposal by November 10th for one piece they want to put in the exhibition. Proposals will consist of one jpeg image file + one pdf file containing:

- student's name
- title of artwork
- a brief description of artwork
- dimensions or running time of artwork
- a detailed list of all requirements and equipment

If a student wishes to submit animation or video work that they feel should be exhibited as a separate video installation, they must propose that and justify it. Animation or video work that does not make a convincing case for a separate video installation will be displayed on a reel with other student work.

Students must propose work made this semester at Pratt, but it could be work from any DDA course, not just the Practicum.

Installation

12/1/16 (Thursday) = main installation date

12/2–5 = additional installation days as necessary

A floor plan has been made up by the Gallery Coordinator, Prof. Katie Torn. Students are responsible for installing the exhibition on the days listed according to Prof. Torn's floor plan.

Installation work will be organized with one student representative from each section. That section's representative will arrange with the other students of his/her section for the details of the installation. The representative is in charge of securing gallery equipment and carts, with overseeing the installation, and with keeping a calendar for installation days & times. The representative will also coordinate with the other sections' representatives as needed.
